Updates and Reminders

- We will not have school, but will offer childcare on Monday, Nov. 11th Veterans Day, if your child will not be attending please let a staff member know, so we can staff accordingly.
- We will be **closed** on Thursday, November 28th and Friday, November 29th for the Thanksgiving Holiday
- For children's safety please drive SLOWLY on our driveway, and be very watchful for children especially when backing up. The speed limit is 10 mph. We thank all those careful drivers who we have seen "creeping" down the driveway at a snail's pace.
- Please DO NOT leave your car running when dropping off or picking up your child. Not only is it dangerous, but illegal.
- Another safety reminder: When coming up the stairs from the toddler area on the lower level, please open the door at the top of the stairs VERY slowly. We have had a couple of hard bumps when the door was opened just at the moment when a child was walking by.
- Please do not give your child gum to chew at school. If your child has gum, please remind them to spit it out before getting to school.

- Please remember to take home your child's sleeping bag and lunch box on Fridays.

Nov. 15th—Thanksgiving Feast

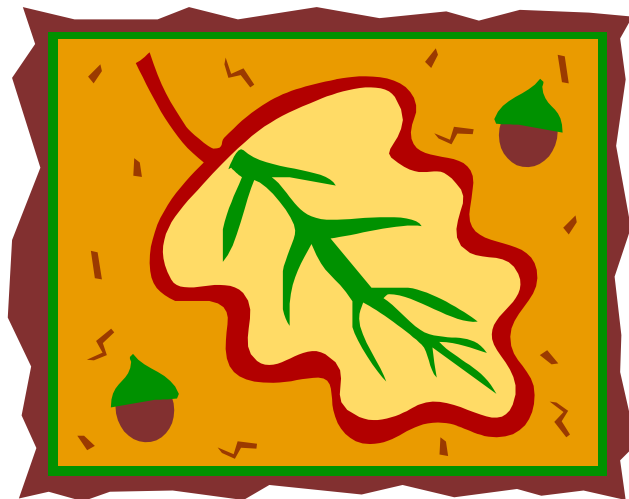
Nov. 28 & 29th— CLOSED, Thanksgiving Holiday
