WELCOME BACK TO SCHOOL!!

- *We warmly welcome both you & your child to Clearview Montessori. We know this will be a great year for us all. In order to make this school year the best possible experience for your family, please read over the policies and suggestions we offer below:*
- **Breakfast is served at 7:00am. Due to a strict time schedule, we need all breakfast eaters at school by this time**
- If your child is full time with us, breakfast is included in your tuition. Breakfast may be purchased for 2.50 or you may purchase a meal ticket for 50.00. If they bring their own breakfast, PLEASE be here ready to eat at 7:00 am
- We close at 6:00 p.m. and we appreciate all children leaving by this time. The late fee starts at 6:01 p.m. The fee is \$5.00 each 5-minute segment or any part of a 5-minute segment. The late fee is payable to the teacher in charge when you pickup your child. We understand there may be circumstances beyond your control, which will interfere with your arrival by 6:00 p.m. If this is a possibility, we appreciate a phone call informing us of your situation and approximate time of arrival. (Regardless of reason - snow, traffic, bridge opening, etc. - the late fee still applies.)
- **Laughing and having fun is encouraged!!!**
- "Show and Tell" is on Friday and is associated with our phonetic study. Starting next Friday, children may bring one item beginning with the letter C. **Please put the object in a paper sack with your child's name and the letter that the item begins with on the outside.**
- Please **LABEL ALL COATS, SHOES, BOOTS HATS, ETC.** On the first day of school, we will have about 40 pairs of new shoes that are all the approximate same size and newness

- All children need fresh air every day, weather permitting. **If your child is too ill to go outside, he/she is too ill to be at school.** Please dress children for the weather (appropriate boots, jackets, hats).
- "How many hours can a child be at school?" The Washington State Department of Social and Health Services states that a child may remain in care a maximum of ten hours each day.

Last Notes

- If your student is with us only for the morning session of school, please be here **PROMPTLY** at 9:00 a.m. Pick up no later than 11:45 or an hourly charge will be applied to your tuition. Please drop off and pick up your children on the outdoor playground (or indoor play area, depending on the weather), as the first and last fifteen minutes of school are reserved for outdoor play and socializing with their peer group.
- Tuitions are due on the **FIRST DAY OF THE MONTH**. Tuitions that have not been paid by the 10th of the month will have a late fee equal to 20% of the tuition billing added to their balance. (Regardless of vacation or illness) You may use Brightwheel or Check.
